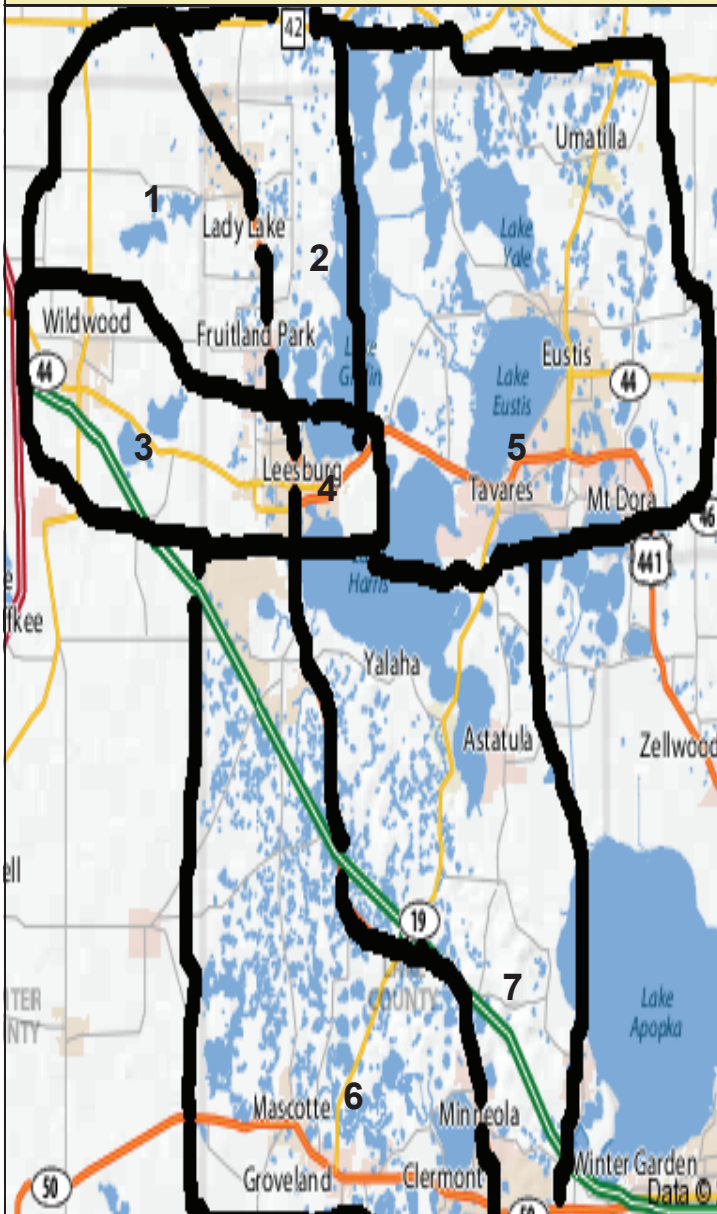
**How Busy is our Food Pantry?**

St. Paul's food pantry is extremely busy? Last month we fed **350 adults** and **313 children** and even more impressive was the distribution of more than **7,000 pounds** of food.

We need your help to feed the hungry of our community. Please develop a habit of buying an extra can of vegetables or fruit, a jar of peanut butter, or jar of pasta sauce each week when you grocery shop. Take advantage of the weekly 2 for 1 specials.

You can bring the pantry items to Mass each week or store them and turn in a large bag full of food when it's your area's featured week to bring food items.

Lastly, if you are a member of our parish family and need some help with food, come to the food pantry, we help those in need and do it **quietly**.

## Parish Religious Education Open House



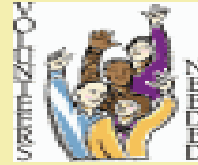
