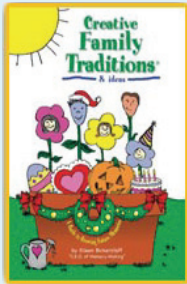

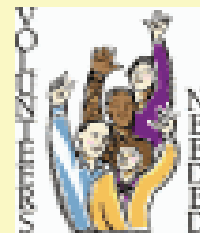

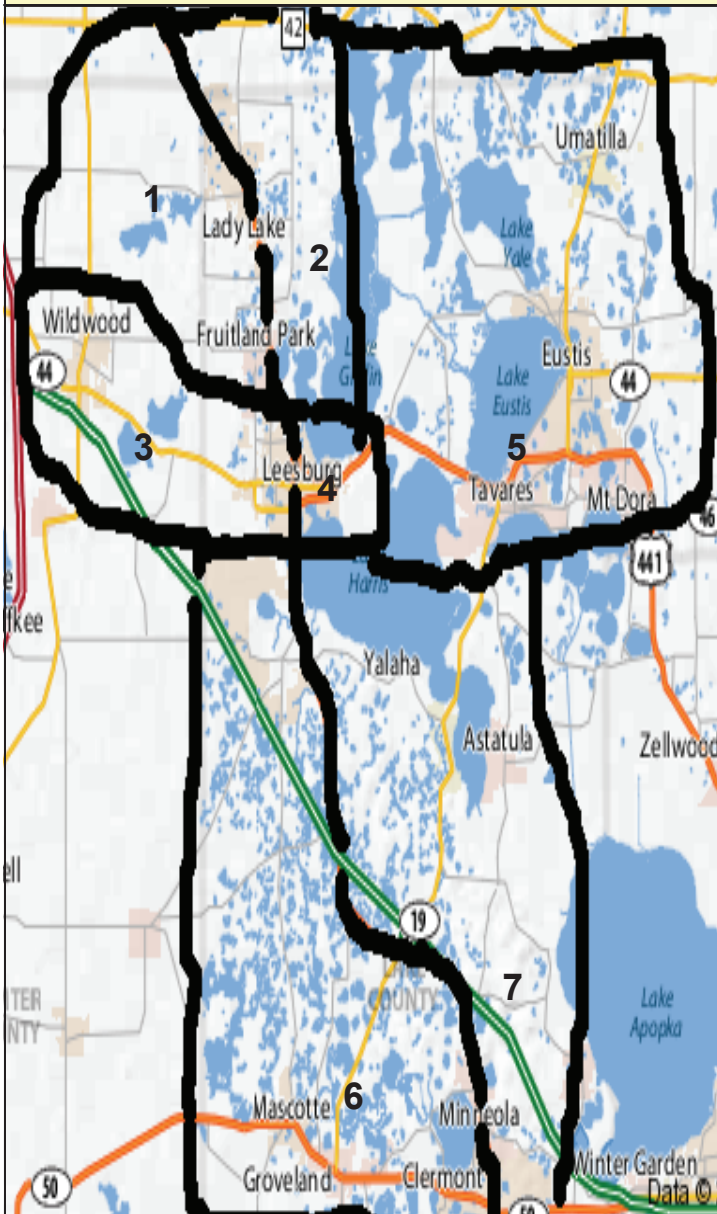

What is it all about?

CHRISTIAN INITIATION

A Journey of Faith for all adults who wish to become members of the Roman Catholic Church. It involves the formation of the total person into a believing, living, praying and a serving member of the church community.

The four-step process includes:

- 1) **EVANGELIZATION/INQUIRY:** A chance for people to ask questions about Catholic beliefs.

- 2) **CATECHUMENATE:** The opportunity for participants to learn about & mature into the Catholic Faith while being guided by a Catholic sponsor.

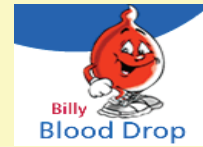
- 3) **ENLIGHTENMENT:** A time for deep spiritual reflection during the Lenten Season. It culminates with the administration of the three Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.

- 4) **MYSTAGOGIA:** A continuous opportunity for spiritual growth & entering fully into the community of Catholic believers.

**ATTENTION
CHURCH PERSONNEL & VOLUNTEERS**

The Diocese of Orlando is required by the United States Catholic Conference of Catholic Bishops to follow certain guidelines with regard to **safe environment training**. As are all other archdioceses and diocese, we are required to undergo regular audits by the USCCB to be sure that we are in compliance with those regulations.

All employees and volunteers in contact with children and vulnerable populations are required to receive this training by the deadlines described below. In addition, the HR Office will be responsible, going forward, for ensuring that all new employees and volunteers receive mandated training. Therefore, in line with the directive, please review the following information.

New Employees & Volunteers

All new employees are required to complete Safe Environment training prior to beginning work. A Diocesan entity will not receive clearance to employ an individual until proof of completed training has been received by the HR/Fingerprinting Office.
