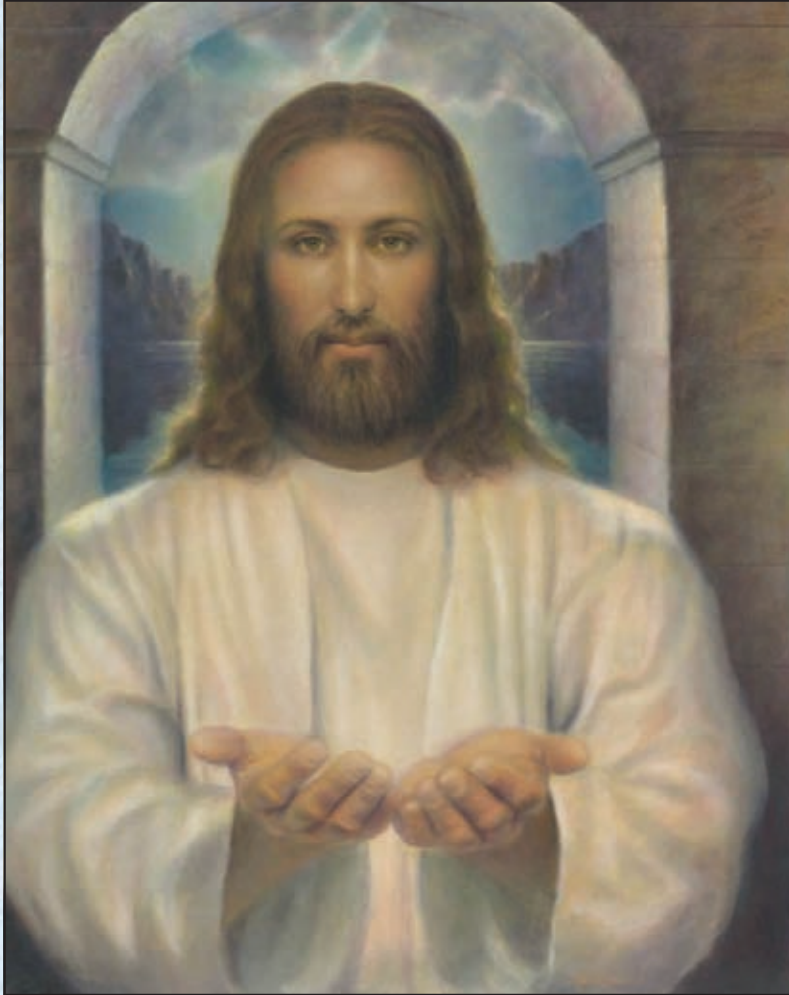

Children's Liturgy of the Word Sunday at 9:00am
Children ages 5-10 leave the assembly and return at the Presentation of Gifts.*

Children's Religious Education Formation for children ages 4 through 8th grade are held Sunday mornings from 10:00am to 11:30am. Children must be registered to attend.* **Registration for St. Paul's Religious Education Program for children age 4 through grade 6 will be held next Sunday, August 12th, and Sunday, August 29th, after the 9:00 and 11:00 am Masses. Registration will be held in room 216 of the Family Enrichment Center. The religious education classes for this age group are held on Sundays following the 9:00am Mass, from 10:00-11:30am.**

Confirmation is a two-year program beginning with 8th grade, and includes those students from St. Paul's School.* **Registration for class will be in August with sessions resuming in September.**

Preparation for Reconciliation/Eucharist The 2nd grade is the usual time for children to prepare for the 1st celebration of the sacraments of Reconciliation & Eucharist. St. Paul's has a parish preparation program that is separate from the Catholic School & the parish school of religious education. Children must be registered, and should have completed a full year of religious instruction before entering the preparation program.

RCIA is the process of inquiring about the Catholic faith. For more information, please contact Deanna Saxton in the Adult Religious Ed Department.

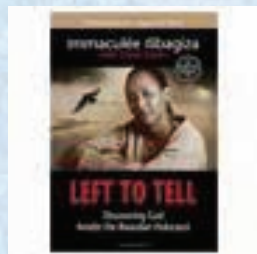
