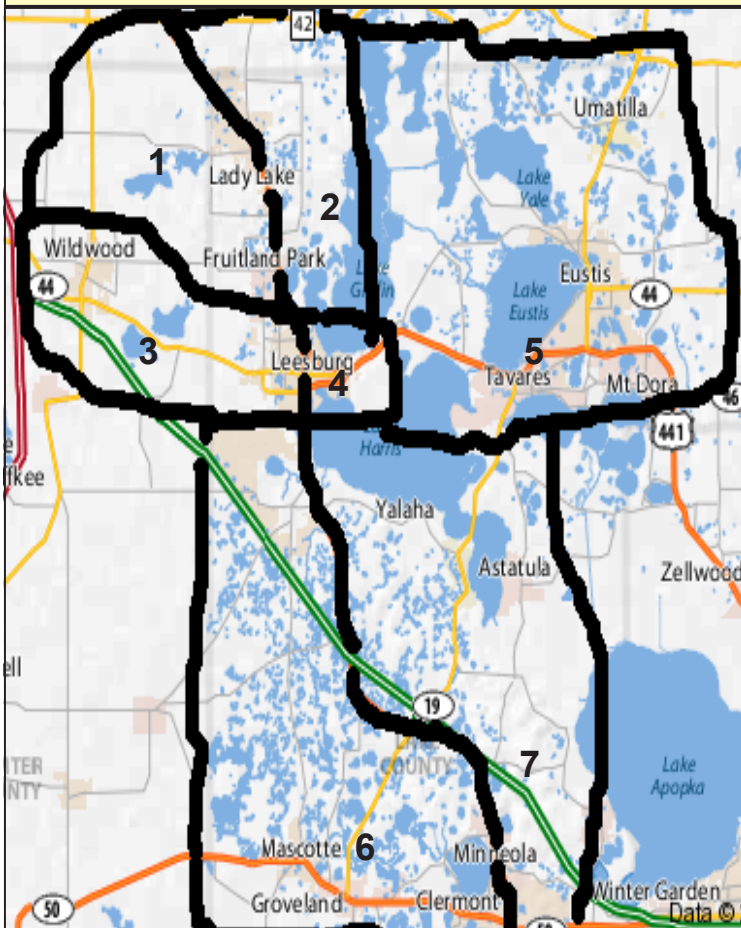


Parishioners in Area 7 are requested to bring food to the pantry or drop it off at church next Sunday.

What is it all about?

CHRISTIAN INITIATION

A *Journey of Faith* for all adults who wish to become members of the Roman Catholic Church. It involves the formation of the total person into a believing, living, praying and a serving member of the church community.

The four-step process includes:

- 1) **EVANGELIZATION/INQUIRY:** A chance for people to ask questions about Catholic beliefs.
- 2) **CATECHUMENATE:** The opportunity for participants to learn about & mature into the Catholic Faith while being guided by a Catholic sponsor.
- 3) **ENLIGHTENMENT:** A time for deep spiritual reflection during the Lenten Season. It culminates with the administration of the three Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.
- 4) **MYSTAGOGIA:** A continuous opportunity for spiritual growth & entering fully into the community of Catholic believers.
