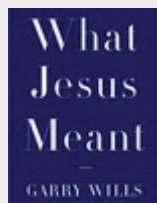

Children ages 5-10 leave the assembly and return at the Presentation of Gifts.*

Children's Religious Education Formation for children ages 4 through 8th grade are held Sunday mornings from 10:00am to 11:30am. Preparation for Reconciliation/Eucharist The 2nd grade is the usual time for children to prepare for the 1st celebration of the sacraments of Reconciliation & Eucharist. St. Paul's has a parish preparation program that is separate from the Catholic School & the parish school of religious education. Children must be registered, and should have completed a full year of religious instruction before entering the preparation program.

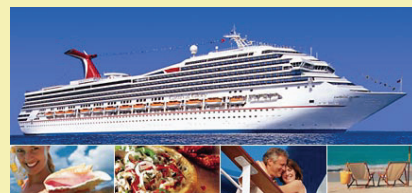
